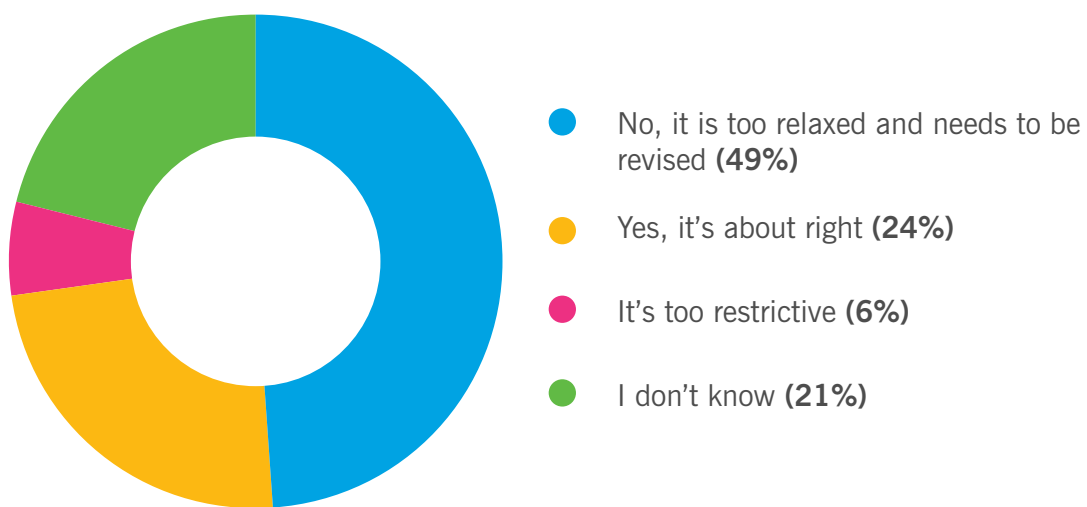
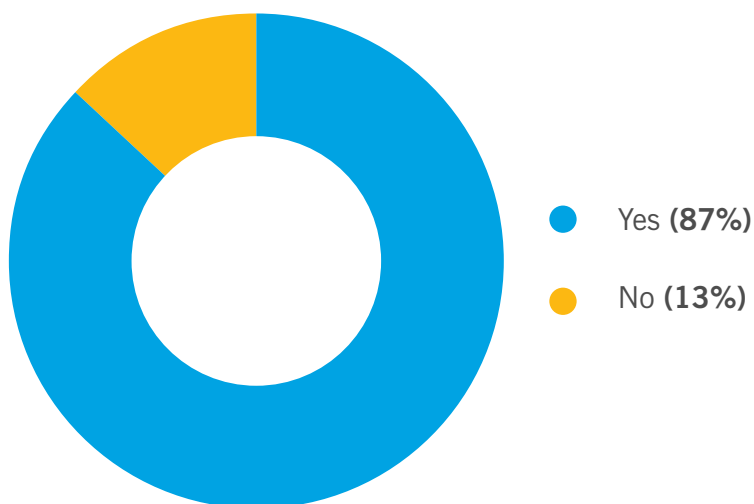

Do you think organisations should be forced to disclose data breaches?

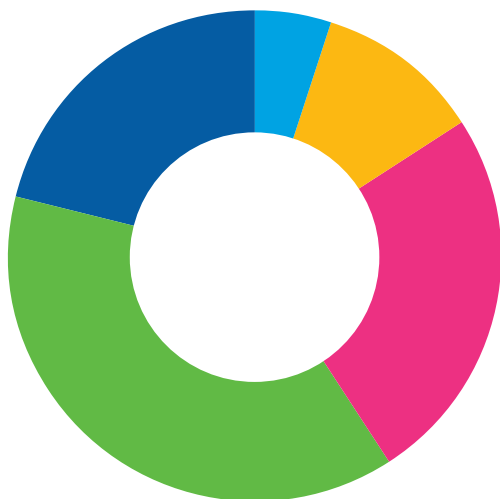


Are you concerned that your organisation may not comply with data protection legislation?



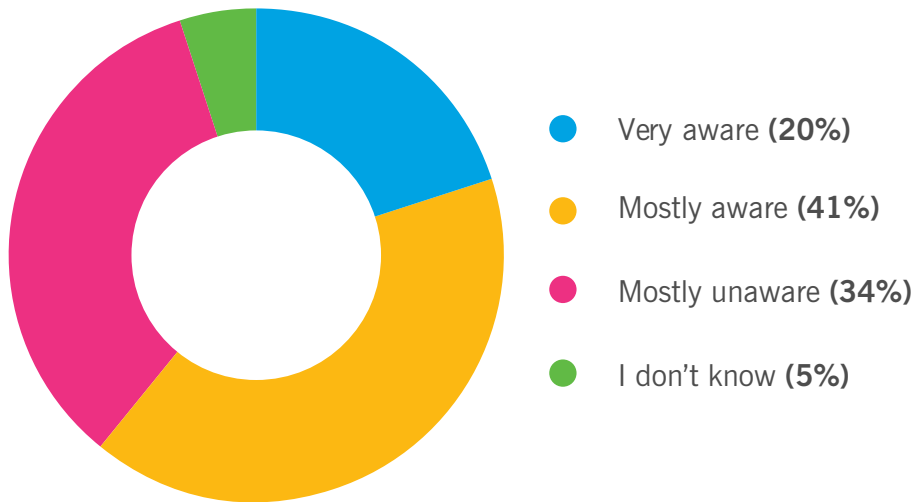
- No, I am confident we are fully compliant **(37%)**

In general, do you feel data protection legislation prevents you from running your organisation effectively?



- Yes, the cost implications of becoming compliant are an issue **(5%)**
- Yes, it means additional complexity for an already overburdened IT department **(11%)**
- Yes, both cost and complexity are an issue **(25%)**
- No, we have effective solutions in place to protect our corporate data **(38%)**
- I don't know **(21%)**
